Noise Check and Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be on Saturday 9th May starting at 15.00, and finishing at 18.00, those competitors who are scrutineering on the Sunday morning between 07.00 and 08.00 are indicated on the attached entry list. On arrival please unload your car in the service area opposite Glaxo Smith Kline (MR 92/054155) (post code DL12 8DT) and report to the noise check as signposted, at noise check collect your numbers which must be fixed to your car before going to scrutineering. Scrutineering is in The Carrosserie Company (UK) (MR 92/053177) (post code DL12 8XT).

Documentation

Signing On is at The Carrosserie Company (UK), you will require your process card together with the relevant 2009 licences, insurance information and club membership cards. If you have not already supplied details of your service vehicle this must be supplied as signing on. Road Book, Rally Plates and Time Cards will be issued at signing on, if only one crew member has completed documentation the Time Card will be withheld until both crew members have signed on. Any outstanding payments must be made at signing on using **cash only**. Start times will be displayed at 08.00 on Sunday morning at the Rally HQ, note first car will start at **09.00**.

Service Area

Only one service vehicle per competitor is permitted in the service area, passes will be issued in the service area as you unload for scrutineering, during the rally if you have no pass there is no admission to the service area. Please park any additional vehicles in the Harmire Enterprise Park. Vehicles and trailers can be left in the service area on Saturday night; this is at the owner's risk.

Rally HQ

For the duration of the rally any questions should go to Rally HQ in the SG Petch caravan in the service area

Start Area

On Sunday morning please unload trailers in the service area, car park opposite Glaxo Smith Kline (MR 92/054155) (post code DL12 8DT) and park trailers as instructed; the start will be at the exit from the service area.

Finish

The Awards presentation is at the Jersey Farm Hotel (MR 92/060170) (post code DL12 8TA), where a food is available; results will be posted at the Jersey Farm Hotel, with awards being presented as soon as the results are final.
